IPMAT /JIPMAT

IPMAT is IPM Aptitude Test. The exam is conducted by IIM Indore for admission to the Five-year Integrated Programme in Management. The score is accepted not only by IIM Indore but also by IIM Ranchi, IIFT Kakinada, NALSAR University Hyderabad, Nirma, and TAPMI for their Integrated BBA+MBA degree.

The **Integrated Program in Management Aptitude Test** (IPMAT) is accepted by 10+ universities, including 5 IIMs (Indore, Rohtak, Jammu, Ranchi, Bodh Gaya). One can take three different IPMATs: IPMAT Indore, IPMAT Rothak, and JIPMAT. The aptitude test is conducted for admission to the five-year IPM program.

JIPMAT aims to produce skilled managers with a 5-year integrated program covering both BBA and MBA degrees. It is a CBT(computer-based test) held across 75 cities in India. Aspirants can expect application forms to be released by the first week of April 2024 for the JIPMAT exam 2024.

Preparation tips to keep in mind

- It is better to moderately learn about several areas over time than to become an expert on just one.
- The candidate must concentrate on taking and evaluating practice tests and mock exams.
- The candidate should mark and promptly revise the weakest portions when analyzing.


