Major manufacturers of athletic shoes have several segmented markets. One segment is based on gender and the other segment is based on the type of sport or activity. They have different promotional campaigns for each market segment. How do they break large markets into smaller ones? Larger markets are most typically divided into smaller target market segments on the basis of geographic, demographic and behaviouristic characteristics. Geographic-the socio-economic structure of rural and urban population is different and affects the purchasing preferences and power. If you are in retail stores business, then your locations within the cities matter. Demographic - customers are individuals and there are many factors that go into the making of an individual personality such as age, race, religion, gender, income level, family size, occupation, education level and marital status.
